## St Pete Pier – Pier Events Specialty District Cup Detail & Characteristics

### Background

City of St. Petersburg Ordinance Section 21-38 establishes the Municipal Pier District as a Specialty Center in which a person may legally possess and consume alcoholic beverages purchased within the district if served in an approved vessel.

### Approved Vessels

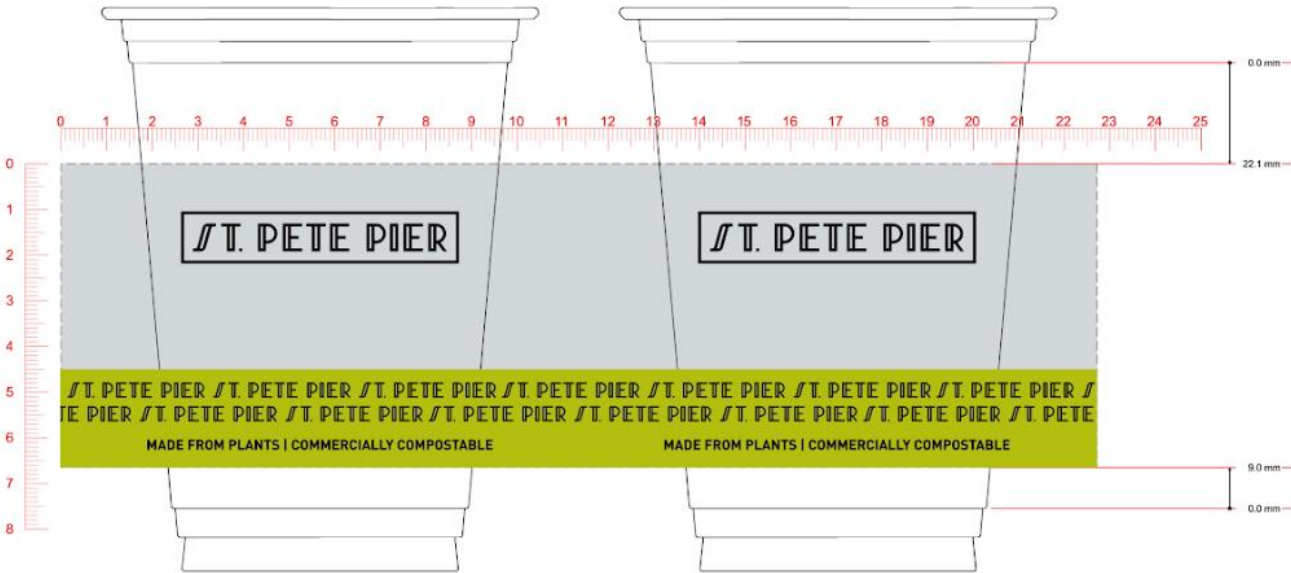
Approved vessels have been agreed upon to be the below pictured 16oz and 9oz cups

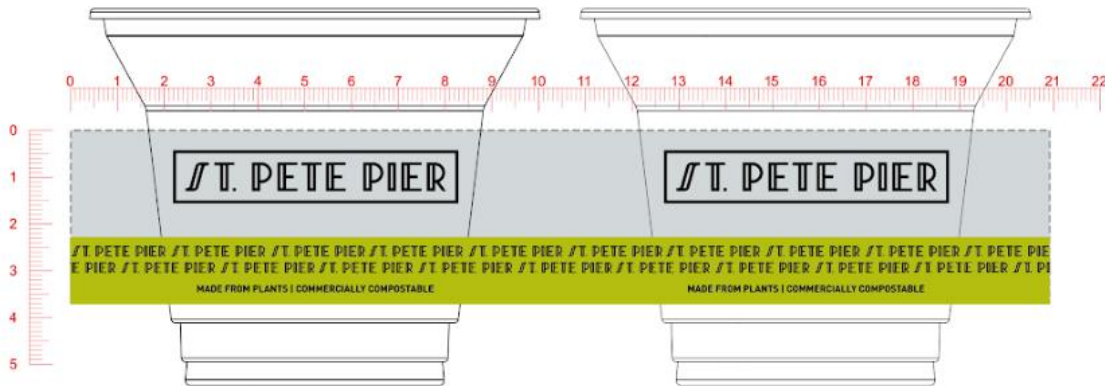


# ARTWORK : 9oz standard cold cup

## Cup Composition

These designated Specialty District Pier Cups are made from PLA (Polylactic Acid) which is derived from renewable resources like corn or sugar cane by a process of fermentation and then polymerization. PLA materials carry the following benefits:

- Not made from petroleum
- Their carbon footprint is 80% lower than plastic cups made from oil-based materials resulting in approximately 80% less greenhouse gasses.
- They are plant based and are 100% compostable certified by Biodegradable Products Institute.
- They naturally degrade when exposed to the environment.
- Non-Toxic, unlike plastic cups which may contain BPA and any other of the several thousand different chemical additives used in plastic production that could leach into the food and the environment and negatively affect the health of humans, marine life and other animals.



### **Pier Tenant Requirements**

Customers intending to leave your premises with an alcoholic drink **MUST** be using the designated pier cups to comply with City Ordinance. Those found to be consuming alcoholic drinks not in a pier cup will be asked to dispose of their drinks immediately by security and/or St. Pete Police Department.

Please assist us in being compliant by serving any to-go drinks in the designated cups and avoid any negative experience for our customers.
